From the Twin Cities, travel Highway 35 to Duluth or turn onto 33 to Cloquet. From those points, Highway 53 takes you directly to Lake Kabetogama and the BEST WALLEYE...

Then follow County Road 122 to our lodge.



ABOUT VOYAGEURS NATIONAL PARK

Kabetogama is one of 5 major lakes in the park, and on Kabetogama alone there are 250 Islands of an acre or more. There is always a safe haven close by in the event of fast moving weather. You can travel 75 miles from Kabetogama to the Vermilion Gorge or a visit to Kettle Falls is an exciting trip. Just minutes north of Arrowhead Lodge is the Kabetogama Peninsula which offers well marked hiking trails leading to many interior wilderness Lakes. The Lakes offer solitude and good fishing, a true wilderness experience for those who pack in and camp overnight or just hike in for the day. A total of over 139,000 acres of pristine wilderness awaits you. Enjoy beautiful wild flowers in the spring, warm sandy beaches, blueberries, and endless blue water in the summer. The awe of the Northern Lights can descend upon you on any particular night. It won't take long for Voyageur Country to cast its spell on you.
